Day 1: Overnight Flight

Day 2: Rome, Italy

Your tour opens in the "Eternal City" of Rome! Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner celebrating the start of your Italian journey. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Rome

Start your day with a locally guided walking tour of Rome's Renaissance and Baroque highlights. Climb to the top of the Spanish Steps for views of

the city's skyline and down its famous 135 stairs. Stroll over cobblestone streets and weathered passageways to discover famous sights such as the Trevi Fountain and the Pantheon's imposing facade. Finish a full morning of exploration in the oval-shaped Piazza Navona, built upon the site of the ancient Stadium of Domitian. The afternoon is yours. Perhaps you'll meander through Rome's lively *Monti* district to soak in the local life. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 4: Rome

Today, join an expert guide to explore the Imperial Fora. Take in views of the Colosseum's exterior, the remains of the Basilica of Maxentius, and of Trajan's Markets. Your extensive walking tour winds its way through Rome's medieval district, which developed organically from the ruins of the ancient city. This neighborhood is a charming combination of narrow cobbled streets, dark tufa stone, and repurposed Roman ruins. Make the most of a free afternoon in Italy's capital city. Perhaps you will join an optional food tour dinner and taste your way around Rome's bohemian *Trastevere* district. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Rome - Pompeii - Amalfi Coast

Journey to the Amalfi Coast, an iconic coastline of rocky beaches and towering cliffs. En route, pause at a local winery to savor the area's famous *Lacryma Christi* wine. Enjoy a typical lunch before experiencing the eerily preserved ruins of Pompeii your way, because **it's your choice!** Join a local guide for an in-depth tour of Pompeii's best-known monuments **-OR-**

venture further afield to discover the hidden corners of this vast archeological site. In the late afternoon, settle into the Amalfi Coast,* your home for the next five nights. Before gathering for dinner, take some time to explore your hotel, perched in a scenic location above the coastline. *Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.*

Day 6: Amalfi Coast

Sail** along the stunning Amalfi Coast to Positano, with its pastel-colored houses and pebbly beaches. Spend time in this legendary locale, browsing the posh boutiques or resting along the beach before continuing to Amalfi. A former trading hub, Amalfi is now a quiet coastal town of historic landmarks and a black-and-white marble cathedral. Explore on your own before returning to your hotel for an evening at leisure. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 7: Amalfi Coast

Journey along the eastern cliffs of the Bay of Naples to the charming resort town of Sorrento. Wander through its narrow streets, perhaps peeking into the peaceful cloister of St. Francis or sampling some gelato made with local lemons. This afternoon, visit a traditional terraced farm and see how cheese is still made by hand. Get a taste of the product at a farm-to-table dinner

capped with homemade limoncello before returning to your hotel in the late evening. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 8: Amalfi Coast

Enjoy a day at leisure to take in the relaxing beauty of the Amalfi Coast. Perhaps you will embark on an optional ferryboat trip*** to the Mediterranean isle of Capri, where you'll enjoy lunch and a locally guided tour before setting out on your own adventure. A two-hour ferryboat ride takes you back to the hotel in the early evening. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 9: Amalfi Coast

This morning, explore Vietri sul Mare, the ceramics capital of the Amalfi Coast. Vietri's quaint lanes exude quintessential Amalfitana vibes thanks to the many buildings decorated with colorful majolica tiles. Enjoy free time to do as you please: climb up the hill for a close-up look at the duomo church or stroll along the waterfront and perhaps dip your feet in the Mediterranean Sea. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner and bid *salute* to the end of your Italian getaway. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 10: Amalfi Coast - Tour Ends

Your tour comes to a close today. *Today breakfast will be included.*

The Amalfi Coast is a favored getaway for Italians and vacationers alike – everyone seeks out its relaxed atmosphere and Mediterranean sunshine. The town of Amalfi itself is a historic center home to a towering marble cathedral and atmospheric piazzas. Amalfi was formerly a thriving trading hub, rivaling that of Venice. As a Maritime Republic, the town made its money through import and export, a legacy still interwoven into its culture today. Although Amalfi is the coast's namesake origin, other towns along the rocky cliffs draw visitors from near and far. Find Sorrento, Positano, and more, all exuding the Amalfi vibe of winding roads, pastel-colored houses, and pebbly beaches. Travel among lemon trees and hillside groves as you make your way along the picturesque coastal drive.

Day 10: Amalfi Coast - Naples

Transfer from the Amalfi Coast to the Bay of Naples. Naples is a city of contrasts: grandiose buildings and expansive plazas beside narrow streets steeped in a medieval atmosphere. A panoramic tour introduces you to Italy's third-largest city. Next, join a local guide for a walking tour of the city's monumental district. Take in the imposing Maschio Angioino castle, the lofty Galleria Umberto arcade, and the expansive Piazza del Plebiscito. After checking in to your hotel in the mid-afternoon, explore the neighborhood, perhaps in quest for Naples most iconic food: pizza!

Day 11: Naples

This morning, explore the vast collections of the Naples National Archeological Museum during a guided tour of its highlights. The museum houses artifacts recovered from the excavations of Pompeii and neighboring towns that were impacted by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 C.E. Continue with a guided walk through Naples' historical old town. Wind your way through this maze-like section of town accompanied by an expert guide and discover its ebullient atmosphere. The afternoon is yours to explore more of Naples on your own. Perhaps you will visit the Capodimonte Museum, famous for its vast collection of Renaissance and Baroque paintings. Or stroll along the Chiaia waterfront and take in views of the Castel dell'Ovo castle, picturesquely perched by the water. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 12: Naples - Depart for Home

Transfer to the airport for your flight home. *Today breakfast will be included.*

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. You can expect some longer days balanced with free time. This level is not a fit for travelers that require mobility assistance devices.

Day 1: Overnight Flight

You are on your way to Florence, the 'Cradle of the Renaissance.'

Day 2: Florence, Italy

Get settled into Florence for your 3-night stay. Your local host will meet you at the hotel for an orientation briefing before leading you on a neighborhood walk, providing you with dining suggestions for your evening at leisure.

Day 3: Florence

Start your morning with a locally guided walking tour of Florence's cultural treasures, passing by the Duomo, the Baptistery, the Palazzo Vecchio, and the Piazza della Signoria. The afternoon is yours to browse the shops of via

Tornabuoni, or perhaps visit one of the city's great museums* such as the Uffizi or the Accademia, which houses Michelangelo's statue of *David*. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 4: Florence

Explore Florence's bohemian *Oltrarno* district during a guided walking tour of the city's Left Bank. *Oltrarno* literally means "on the other side of the Arno," the river which runs through Florence. Grasp the spirit of this "Florence of the Florentines." here the last craftsmen, the market stalls, the gardens and churches, the typical restaurants and cafés still move at the gentle rhythm of everyday life, away from the hustle and bustle of Florence's more famous monuments. The *Oltrarno* was so dear to the Medici family – Florence's great rulers – that they made it their home by establishing themselves in the Pitti Palace. The remainder of the day is yours to explore more of Florence. Perhaps you'll venture up to Piazzale Michelangelo, a panoramic terrace offering charming views over the city's towers and domes. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Florence - Rome

Your Florentine sojourn comes to a close today. Say *Arrivederci!* as you transfer to Rome by high-speed train** to begin your tour. *Today breakfast will be included.*

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you.
